Colored Crayons For most of us, colored pencils were a commonly used medium in art classes growing up. Not only are they ideal art media to learn your skills, but they are also used to create beautiful professional artwork. Colored pencils can be used to create very simple line drawings, or to create highly detailed and expressive artwork that, when used correctly, can even look photorealistic. Ink and quill Feather and ink have also been used as artistic means for centuries. Ink is great for creating solid contours, but must be used with a steady hand and very carefully, as ink cannot be erased. Ink and the pen have been used for centuries to create complex graphics as well as textual art forms such as calligraphy. Modeling also includes the delicate and intricate art of glassblowing and glass casting, created by skilled glass artists. These methods require an oven or kiln to heat the glass in order to shape it using techniques such as glass melting and tempering. Many techniques can also be applied to cold glass, such as grinding, polishing and then etching or etching glass using different methods of decorating the glass surface.
